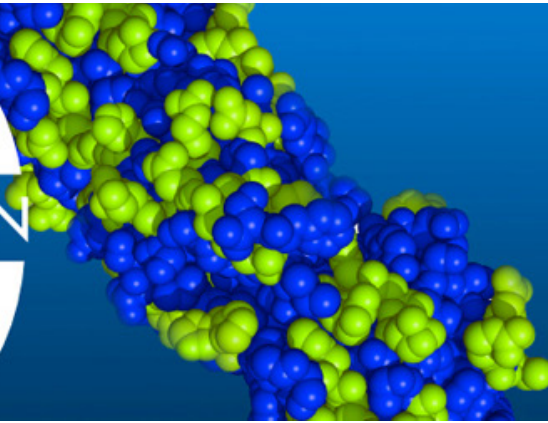

Douglas A. Cox '66 is an expert in vacuum distillation utilizing high performance packing, and has led projects that enhanced process yields and capacity as well as improve quality and reduce energy usage at leading chemical companies. He retired from Eastman Chemical Company as senior research associate in 2006.

Beginning his career at Hercules Inc, he progressed through the company via technical and managerial roles including line supervisor, area supervisor, technical manager, and plant manager at plants in North Carolina, Missouri, Georgia and New Jersey.

In 1992 he transferred to the Wilmington, DE corporate office, where he was appointed engineering manager of the resins department. He remained there until Eastman acquired the department in 2001, at which time he transitioned to his final position.

During his career Douglas also led the start-up and expansion of five process lines, and used his expertise to complete his last Eastman project, which consolidated production of two oil fractionation plants into one.
