Arthur L. Goldstein '59M is the former chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Ionics Inc., a world-renowned business and technology pioneer in water purification. Retired from the company since 2004, during his 32-year tenure as CEO he led the company in its growth from a small R&D company to a world leader with more than 4,000 installations in 62 countries.

Art has also been extensively involved in the scientific and academic community. He is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, where he also serves as a member of the trust. Additionally he is a senior trustee at the California Institute of Technology and an emeritus member of the Energy Initiative External Advisory Board at MIT.

He is the Chairman of the Board of Overseers of the International Business School at Brandeis University and is Chairman of the Board of Sun Catalytix Corporation. He has also served as trustee and chairman of the Finance Committee and treasurer of Partners HealthCare; trustee of the Massachusetts General Physicians Organization; director of Cabot Corporation; director of State Street Corporation; director of Jobs for Massachusetts; trustee of Dana-Farber/Partners Cancer Care; member of the Visiting Committees at the Harvard Business School and the Harvard School of Public Health; and as president of the Rensselaer Council.

Art also holds 19 U.S. patents related to the purification and processing of liquids and in the area of healthcare. He received his bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, and a master's in business administration from Harvard University.
