



## ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

Anthony J. McHugh '71M, '72PhD has had an influential career in higher education for almost 40 years. He is currently the Ruth H. and Sam Madrid Professor of Chemical and Biomolecular Engineering at Lehigh University.

As an expert in polymer science and engineering, membrane formation and controlled-release drug delivery, Tony has published more than 200 articles and presented his work on more than 250 occasions. His lab has also been instrumental in modeling various aspects of polymer processing.

Tony is also highly regarded for his inspirational teaching methods and emphasizing the importance of research in the classroom. While serving on the faculty at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign between 1979 and 2002, he received the School of Chemical Sciences Teaching Award and Engineering Council Award for Excellence in Advising. At Lehigh he has served as chair of the department, and his graduate students have excelled in industry and academia.

In addition to his primary appointments, Tony has served as visiting professor at Drexel University and the University of Delaware. He is a member of the External Advisory Board for the Chemical Engineering and Materials Science Department at Stevens Institute of Technology, and a member of the McGill University Chemical Engineering Department Review Committee.

For his achievements and contributions, Tony was elected a fellow of the AIChE in 2012. He has also received the Alan Glanville Award from the Institute of Materials, Minerals and Mining, and the Humboldt Senior Scientist Award.
