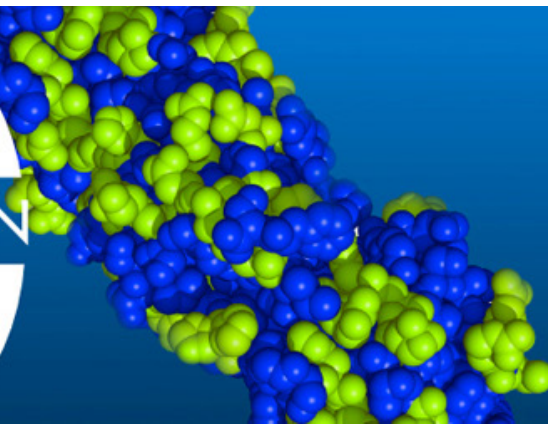


100 YEARS OF INNOVATION
