E. Alan Uebler '64M, '66PhD has dedicated his career to intellectual property law for more than 35 years. Currently practicing in Wilmington, DE, his firm focuses on issues related to patents, trademarks, copyrights, trade secrets, antitrust and unfair competition.

Al earned his juris doctorate degree from the University of Maryland in 1974 while serving as corporate counsel at W.L. Gore & Associates. After three years, he left the company to briefly provide his expertise to The DuPont Company as a member of the corporate patent counsel.

Switching to private practice in 1978, he began taking on state and federal cases and has prosecuted hundreds of patents to issue worldwide. In addition to his primary career, Al has taught basic IP law in the UD chemical engineering department for more than 30 years.

For his contributions and accomplishments, Al received the Outstanding Alumni Award from UD's engineering alumni association in 2009. He is also a member of numerous professional organizations, including the National Lawyers Association, the American Intellectual Property Law Association and the American Institute of Chemical Engineers, among others.

Prior to his career in law, Al worked as a research engineer for DuPont. He received his bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from the University of Illinois in 1962.
